<b>SmartSearch</b>	Search across multiple Discus databases at once. Your SmartSearch retrieves search results from the Explora list above plus <i>Academic Search Premier, Bloom’s Literature, Britannica School, Business Source Premier, Credo, Education Full Text, Gale in Context: Biography, Gale in Context: Opposing Viewpoints, and LEARN360</i> .
